PREVENT Workshops will introduce skills and knowledge necessary to prevent violence before it happens. Two-day workshops will focus on defining and understanding the idea of preventing violence as well as introducing program planning and evaluation techniques to approach the work. This is an introductory-level Workshop and most helpful to those who are just beginning to think about how to prevent violence before it starts. All who work in the area of violence prevention, across the spectrum of violence (domestic violence, sexual assault, youth violence, child maltreatment, suicide prevention, etc.), will benefit from this workshop and are encouraged to apply.

The PREVENT Workshop will help your team:

- ✓ ***Introduce an understanding of how to prevent violence before it occurs***
- ✓ ***Learn and practice basic skills to plan and evaluate prevention activities***
- ✓ ***Develop networks of colleagues also working in violence prevention***
- ✓ ***Get started on a violence prevention project and receive coaching assistance about that project for three months***

TO APPLY: You must be part of a team of 3-5 individuals to participate in this workshop. **Each member of the team must register** for the workshop on the **PREVENT website** (www.PREVENT.unc.edu). 60 individuals (approximately 15 teams) can participate in each workshop.
